

NEWTOWN CROSSING COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

Membership:

1. Pool membership is limited to the members of the community who are in good standing of the Newtown Crossing Community Association and their families who are residents of Newtown Crossing. The Association reserves the right to ask for proof of residency of any person who is listed on a pool application. Families will only receive membership for those individuals that live in the household. NCCA assessments must be current before a pool application may be approved.
2. Individuals or family members who reside outside of Newtown Crossing may not obtain membership through a NCCA resident. Any NCCA resident who is involved in such an act will have their pool membership revoked.

Pool Hours:

1. The pool opens for the season on Memorial Day weekend. The pool will be open weekends until mid-June. Then, the pool will be open daily from 12:00-8:00 P.M. until Labor Day.
2. The pool is available to rent for private parties on any night from 8:00-10:30 P.M. The contact person for rentals is Marie Dempsey at (215)630-3502. There is a \$75 rental charge, plus the cost of the lifeguards per hour. There needs to be one lifeguard for every 20 people swimming in the pool.
3. All persons are required to leave the pool promptly at closing time.
4. Bennington Pool Services has the authority to close the pool at any time, without notice, when it is necessary for the safety of the swimmers. In the event of inclement weather, it is the discretion of Bennington Pools and the lifeguards to open or close the pool. The pool must be closed for thirty minutes after the last lightning or thunder. In the event of rain, the pool will remain open until the bottom of the pool is no longer visible.

Pool Admission:

1. Every person who enters the pool area must have a photo pool tag with them every time. You will be sent home to retrieve your tag if you come to the pool without it.
2. NCCA is not responsible for the loss or damage of personal property. Please leave your valuables at home.
3. Children 12 years and younger must be accompanied by a responsible adult who is 16 years or older.
4. All persons use the pool at their own risk. NCCA will not be responsible for any accident or injury. In the event of an injury, you must notify the lifeguards immediately.

5. Parents or guardians are responsible for explaining the pool rules to their children. The baby pool is not monitored by the lifeguards. Parents must watch their children while their swimming in the baby pool.

Admission of Guests

1. The Association reserves the right to limit the number of guests per member. If you intend on having more than three guests on a specific day, you must notify the lifeguards at least three days in advance.

2. Daily guest passes cost \$5 per guest. The cost will be reduced to \$2 after 4:00 P.M.

3. A 20 visit guest pass costs \$60, and can be purchased at the pool by check payable to NCCA or cash. Unused guest passes can be used the following year.

4. All guests must be accompanied by a NCCA member.

Rules of conduct, health, and safety

1. Please drive slowly when entering and exiting the parking area.

2. No alcoholic beverages on the pool grounds.

3. No smoking inside the gates of the pool area.

4. The use of the baby pool is for toddlers only. These children are the sole responsibility of their parents or guardians, and must be supervised at all times. The lifeguards are not monitoring the baby pool.

5. Appropriate bathing attire must be worn in the pool. Men must wear bathing suit bottoms, no cut offs or jeans.

6. Please do not use the pool as a bathroom.

7. The use of rafts is allowed with the permission of the lifeguards.

The following are PROHIBITED:

1. Swimming while there is no lifeguard on duty.

2. Diving in the shallow end of the rope

3. Alcoholic beverages

4. Smoking

5. Pets

6. Any horseplay, or throwing or pushing others into the pool.

7. Glass containers

8. Entering the pool while under the influence of any substance.
