Welcome back to the 2016 Summer season! The pool will open on May 28, 2016 on weekends only. It will be open fulltime a few weeks after Memorial Day. The hours of operation are 12:00 PM-8:00 PM. Please note that a child must be 12 years old to swim without a parent or a guardian over 16 years old. We will be using Bennington Pool Services as our management company this year.

### **Pool Registration**

If you want to cool off in the pool this summer, please complete the pool registration form, which can be found at newtowncrossing.info. Then, put your form in the mailbox at 206 Hidden Valley Lane. The registration form must be completed and approved PRIOR to using the pool. There is no additional fee for residents to use the pool, however all NCCA assessment payments must be up to date. Non-residents are required to pay \$5.00 daily and must enter with a resident. A 20 visit pass for guests can be purchased with your registration. We will again be using photo passes, so please bring your passes from last year to show to the lifeguards when you enter the pool area. If you need a new photo, there will be an opportunity to have your picture taken in May and June so that there is no wait to use the pool.
