Pool News

Welcome back to the 2019 Summer season! The pool will open on weekends starting May 25th. It will be open full-time on June 17, 2019. The hours of operation are 12:00 P.M.-8:00 P.M. Please note that a child must be at least 12 years old to swim without a parent or a guardian who is over 16 years old.

We will be using Bennington Pool Services again this year. If your child would like to lifeguard at our pool, please contact <u>Benningtonpoolservices.com</u>.

Pool Registration

The 2019 pool registration form can be found on newtowncrossing.info. Please complete and mail your form to 206 Hidden Valley Lane. The registration form must be completed and approved PRIOR to pool use. There is no additional fee for residents to use the pool, but all NCCA assessment payments must be up to date. Non-residents are required to pay \$5.00 daily and must enter with a resident. A 20 visitor pass can be purchased with your registration or at the pool. We will be using picture passes again this year. Passes must be shown to the lifeguards every time you enter the pool area. If possible, please bring your passes from last year. In May and June, there will be opportunities to have your picture taken if necessary.
