Why are we still asking residents to vote in an election in which candidates are running unopposed?

Instead of an outside company, Newtown Crossing is managed by volunteer board members. They are residents elected by residents, and by serving as volunteers, they help keep our assessments among the *very lowest in the county*. The only thing you need to do is vote.

According to the bylaws of the Newtown Crossing Community Association an election is not valid unless a minimum of 63 votes are received. The board members on the ballot below are asking to be reelected so they can continue serving the community...for free.

At the last meeting it was revealed that we had received fewer than 30 votes.

This election takes place only once a year. Please take 2 minutes and fill out the ballot on the next page. Just follow the instructions; it will help keep our Board of Directors functioning in the effective and efficient manner to which we are accustomed.

1. Place an "X" in the block of the candidate(s) you are supporting for the open position(s) on the Board of Directors of the NCCA.
2. Print your name and address in the space provided and sign and date this form. If your home is jointly owned, both should sign.
3. Place this ballot in a sealed envelope marked "NCCA ELECTION BALLOT".
4. Mail to NCCA, 206 Hidden Valley Lane, Newtown. Envelopes may also be given to a neighbor who will be attending the next General Membership Meeting and Annual Meeting on July 2.
5. Ballots brought to the meeting will be collected during the meeting.
6. Only ballots properly signed and placed in sealed envelopes will be accepted.

Vote for two (2). Space is provided for write-in vote.

A minimum number of votes must be received for the election to be valid. Even though there are only 2 declared candidates for the 2 open seats, please take a moment to vote.
